Using ChargerNet Chargers

ChargerNet chargers are being managed as part of the Charge-Your-Car Network.

To use the chargers you can either join Charge-Your-Car and have an account or use their pay as you go service. (For more information visit their website www.chargeyourcar.org.uk)

Rapid Chargers will charge all vehicles and if your vehicle has rapid charge capability, your vehicle battery is charged to 80% of capacity in around 20-30 minutes.

There will be a fee to use the Rapid Chargers, to cover the energy and operational costs. We currently have an introductory offer for ChargerNet users of £4.00 a charge for the first 60 minutes (usual cost is £6.00), This is enough to complete your charge, if you stay longer the price increases to £12. Please move on once you have completed your charge to allow others to use the charger.

Innovative technology built into the equipment detects when a vehicle is parked at the charger and Civil Enforcement Officers will be alerted if a vehicle parks in the space without being connected to the charger. Illegally parked vehicles will be liable to a parking penalty charge.
